



From Despair to Hope A Ukrainian Refugee's Journey

Amid the turmoil of the Russian invasion in February 2022, a Ukrainian family found their lives irrevocably altered. The nation they had regarded as a brotherly ally became an unforgiving battlefield, and their world was shaken to its core.

Urgently summoned by their daughter, the family faced the heart-wrenching decision to abandon the home they had built over the years, a cherished six-room house at the heart of their town, and the thriving local café they had lovingly operated.

The relentless winter added to their suffering as power and gas vanished, leaving them to endure frigid temperatures that plummeted to -10°C. They resorted to desperate measures to ward off the cold, improvising with whatever materials they could find. Each night brought an unceasing barrage of shelling and bombings, forcing them into makeshift bomb shelters. Fear for their grandchildren and the young ones in their community gnawed at their hearts.

A visit to their once-thriving café unveiled a scene of devastation; "when we had the chance to check on our café we found that the marauders stripped all the metallic material and copper wiring from the building. All the work and money we invested in this place, it was sad to see. We knew it was time to leave and we joined those waiting for convoys to leave for the next safe point".

Their exodus became a painful necessity. The arduous journey to safety in Poland took nine grueling days, marked by the constant threat of hidden mines lurking beneath their path. "It had great affect on our health as we didn't rest, we were stressed, we didn't know what was next. Sleepless nights, waking up crying, dreams about our home, the life we had. Now gone."

Following their long journey to Poland, the family made their way to the U.S.. In their new home, gratitude blossomed; particularly toward their daughter, the Polish family that had provided them refuge at the border, and kind-hearted individuals like CLCHC's Founder & CEO, Sergey, who offered support, resources, and essential knowledge about Medi-Cal, which saved them a substantial amount of money. In this foreign land, amid uncertainty and upheaval, they found solace in the outstretched hands of those willing to help.

The family reflects, "Sergey is an amazing person; one time he stayed with us for two hours making sure we understood everything and had all that we needed during our visit. He was so committed to helping us. We really appreciate the patience with translations. Everyone is friendly, accommodating, and cares about us when we are here for an appointment. We are fortunate to have so much help."

A Mother's Testimony

As CLCHC continues to grow, we gratefully listen to the stories told by our wonderful patients and hear first-hand how our clinic has positively impacted their lives. Mrs. Jasmine Valdivia, a soon-to-be graduate of Saddleback College and a proud mother, has trusted Celebrating Life with her son lan's care since he was born nearly three years ago. Little lan is a patient of Claudine Yamaoka, one of our Nurse Practitioners at the clinic. Jasmine shared with us her experience at CLCHC and why she has continued to trust us to care for her little one:

[My son] is a few months from turning 3 years old. He is the first grandchild from my side and is super loved. He is very loving and smiley, and loves the outdoors and going to the park and pool. I already knew of CLCHC before becoming pregnant because of family and friends, and have been taking [my son] here since he was born. I wanted something close to us and to the hospital in case of an emergency. Claudine is amazing. She always goes above and beyond and always listens to my concerns and acts on them. Any questions I have she tries to answer as soon as possible. She is open minded, she genuinely cares, and she is super sweet. I've only ever had positive experiences with Celebrating Life!

Jasmine is one of many parents who want nothing but the absolute best for their child, and we are grateful to provide her son the care he, and every child, deserves.




